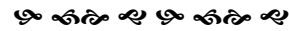

## **Help Meet Trinity Academy's \$35,000 Challenge**

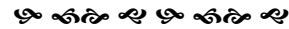
Trinity Academy has been blessed with a challenge grant of \$35,000. A Trinity parishioner will match every dollar donated to support Trinity Academy between now and May 31 up to \$35,000. The total of \$70,000, if realized, would support school operations for more than two months! Trinity Academy is the only tuition-free, independent Episcopal School in Connecticut, presently serving students in grades 2 through 4. We are changing the lives of 39 students almost all of whom are from the City of Hartford. The school offers an extended day (7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) including breakfast, lunch and two healthy snacks. The goal is to expand to serve 1<sup>st</sup> graders in the 2018-2019 academic year.

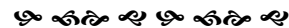

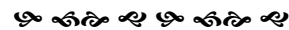
