SAFE CHURCH TRAINING

Who needs to take this brief course? The diocese strongly encourages safe church training on the prevention of abuse and exploitation of both children and adults for all lay ministers in positions of parish leadership, whether paid or volunteer.

These educational offerings are strongly encouraged for **church school teachers, anyone who sees people in their homes on behalf of the church, e.g. Eucharistic Visitors or parish visitors, vestry members, officers, and anyone who works with children and youth.**

All lay persons are welcome and invited to attend safe church trainings. **Certification and recertification is free and renewal is once every five years.** If you have already taken the course and need to check on your status, contact Fran Times-Mack in the parish office.
