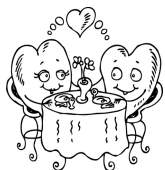
## Bushnell Park: Feeding the Homeless

## TEDS EDUCATION UPDATE:

Over the past week there have been two reports that are of interest to friends of Trinity Episcopal Day School. First, the NY Times reported the high — and continually rising — cost of a private school education in NYC is now more expensive than attending Harvard. The annual tuition, even for the lowest grades, is hovering on the brink of 40K per year. Second: a January report jointly published by Duke & Harvard researchers (*End of the Segregated Century: Racial Separation in ... Neighborhoods, 1890-2010*) concludes that there is far more residential integration throughout our cities than at any point in our past but that "too many Americans still lack the opportunity to achieve meaningful success."

TEDS is stepping into this breach, helping build a strong foundation for all students to be successful by creating an educational program focused on rigorous academics, integrating the arts as well as infusing faith and values to make excellent education affordable for all. Look for more news as we prepare for startup: Trinity Episcopal Day School ([www.trinityday.org](http://www.trinityday.org)) opening in Fall 2012.
